Managing the applying of the regulations in each country can be difficult. Our experience with local regulations and requirements can help to reduce and remove these obstacles, assuring in this way, the success of the business operations. AENOR is part of a wide net of knowledge of international regulations, which is offered to their clients.

Selection and Assessment of suppliers

We help our clients to make a preliminary selection of suppliers that supply the product that is required. The service can go further, revising installations, technical, production or logistic skills, as well as the quality level of the product that they make.

Ethic and environmental Audits at factory

Aspect as important as Health and Safety at work, the use of child labour or forced labour, over-time, salaries, discrimination, discipline and plant organization, as well as the use, staring and management in the processes of raw materials destruction, production and wastes, among others, are assessed in order to protect the image and commercial brand of the import company and assure the fulfilment of social, ethic and environmental regulations by suppliers.

Inspection and control at origin

It is an inspection in plant to set if the product, equipment or installation fulfil the client's necessities and expectations, the applying of the regulation, the contract conditions or any other requirement defined before expedition.

A control programme is defined to fix the frequency and effect of the service, including from the verification of the proposed design, visual inspection of the product (revising dimensions, quality, function, packaging, labelling, special products specifications, etc. ...) to the trials tests, functional, electrical and mechanical trials, and any other established criteria.

Monitoring approval tests of equipment in plant (FAT)

In order to verify that products/installations/

equipment are adapted to the function to which they were designed for, according to the buyer's instructions and current regulation, AENOR technical team moves to the production place to monitor the Final Assessment Tests of the equipment made following the set conditions in the Purchase Agreements.

Inspection for industrial projects monitoring

The supervision of the evolution of all the phases of an order or a project, to control and minimize any deviation to the planned covers from the inspection of personal equipment to the supervision of complete projects, including the protocols and specifications of each client. It is applicable to any type ofmechanical, electrical, electronic or instrumental equipment and the expedition time in any industrial sector.

Sampling and product tests

Once sampling is done in plant, the select product can be sent to an authorised lab to do the tests requested by the client depending on the product and the country.

Containers loading and unloading supervision

It is assured that the final details of the product are those that were agreed, that the required quantity is correctly stowed in the container and that the container is properly sealed. In the same way, the inspector can be on site when the goods are unloaded to check the quantity and the product conditions when arriving, as well as if the seal of the container has been manipulated.

Inspections of loading and unloading of product in bulk

This is the monitoring of the transport of the product in bulk about quantitative and qualitative aspects. A product control is carried out while loading and unloading by specific procedures.

Inspection at destination

The verification by an independent organism about the state of the product that is received is a tool used in commercial contracts to assure quality.
